DELEGATE DETERMINATION GUIDE

Article V, Section 2 of the National By-Laws dictate that each Post *in good standing* (10 members minimum) is entitled to four (4) delegates. In addition, a Post shall be entitled to one (1) additional delegate for each additional ten (10) members in excess of fifteen (15). As the membership count in the Post reaches these plateaus, their delegate entitlement is earned.

Applicable provisions of the National Constitution & By-Laws:

- Current National Officers, Past National Commanders & Past National Chaplains, Department and Chapter Commanders shall be entitled to a delegate vote at National Conventions. No delegate shall have more than single suffrage (one vote).
- The delegate representation for each Post in good standing shall be determined by that Post’s paid membership as June 1 prior to the Annual Convention. The National Department will notify each Post of its delegate strength not later than July 1.
- Headquarter’s Posts are not entitled to suffrage at any Convention or election meetings **unless it has delegates physically present.**

Delegate fees for the determined delegate strength of a Post are due to the National Office NOT LATER THAN the Monday of the week prior to the Opening of the Annual Convention.

The hand carrying of delegate registration to the Convention is authorized, *provided these delegates are registered and paid prior to the Opening Session of the Annual Convention.*
