RULES for CONTESTS

- 1. Grade eligibility listed for each contest.
- 2. Posters are to be standard size 11 x 14 inches only. Any type of cardboard or paperboard is OK.
- 3. Students in Contests "A", "B", and "D" may be more creative even attaching items to the poster. Winning posters may be shipped, and students should avoid designs in which the effect may be lost if crushed during transit.
- 4. For Contest "C", Grades K-2, the student will use a theme of Valentine's Day. Students should choose a page from a coloring book that illustrates the theme and color it. These pages are to be submitted in the same way as the posters and will be judged in the same way as the posters.

5. THE 3VC IDENTIFICATION FORM MUST BE COMPLETED FOR EACH ENTRY AND BE ATTACHED TO EACH ENTRY.

- 6. Only three (3) Entries are to be submitted by each Department per contest.
- 7. Posts and Auxiliaries not under Department jurisdiction may only submit one (1) poster per contest.
- 8. All entries must be received by the National Third Vice Commander at address listed below **BEFORE** the deadline date. **Late entries will NOT be judged.**
- 9. The decision of the judges is final.
- 10. Contestants need not be present to win.
- 11. If you would like your entries returned from National, please include a note indicating this.

Length is limited to 2 typed pages (If two pages are used, one side per page, 12 point type). Typing is strongly recommended for readability. **Any evidence of plagiarism** will disqualify the entry.
- 3. Contest Rules (5 through 9) above will apply to Essay Contest.
