Note: Contest winners are selected by grade in each category and the judging is done by various organizations within our Catholic community. For example, the winners for last year's Christmas Poster were selected by the National 3VC's Parish priest and a few of the lay people. Every effort is made to ensure that the judging is both fair and impartial.

REPORTS

Third Vice Commanders at each echelon are responsible for submitting two semi-annual reports. Third Vice Commanders wishing to augment their reports with additional detail may do so, e.g. description of each Youth Activity that your Echelon sponsored.

A copy of these Reports should be sent **directly to EVERY higher echelon 3VC** (one copy each to Chapter, one to Department and one to National) for each Reporting Period. Reports can be sent as an e-mail attachment. Please time your reports to arrive at each higher Echelon as follows:

First Report (covers June 16 - December 31)

Post Report to Chapter 3VC by January 1st

Post and Chapter Reports to Department 3VC by January 10th

Post, Chapter, and Department Reports to National 3VC by January 15th

Second Report (Covers January 1- June 15)

Post Report to Chapter 1VC by June 1st

Post and Chapter Reports to Department 3VC by June 10th

Post, Chapter, and Department Reports to National 3VC by June 15th

IMPORTANT NOTE: All reports should be submitted on the National Third Vice Commander's Report Form attached to this program. Time your mailing or emailing of reports so they arrive at the National 3rd Vice Commander by the deadline dates listed above. The National 3rd Vice Commander's address is:

We welcome personal commentary and constructive evaluation of every echelon 3rd Vice Commander. Some phases of this program have been tried and tested over the years. Other areas are new. We are always looking for new innovations. We are soliciting your assistance in this regard. We want your positive input and constructive criticism.

This program requires a considerable amount of time and effort. The following are a few suggestions:

- 1. Please read the requirements for each activity/contest.
- 2. Please make note of the cutoff-due date for leach activity.
- 3. Document everything you do, as it relates to your programs.
- 4. Please use the required documents contained in this package, for each activity/contest.
- 5. Check the National Web site and take advantage of forms provided.
- 6. When possible, submit forms via chain of command by e-mail.
- 7. Finally, transfer all documented youth activity/contest to the Youth Activity Report Form and mail to the National 3rd Vice Commander at the address listed above.
