The ICB Scholarship is offered to high school seniors who are sons, daughters, grandsons, or granddaughters of an active member of the Catholic War Veterans of the United States of America or of the Catholic War Veterans Auxiliary. A child or grandchild of a deceased Veteran is also qualified. A student may apply for both Veterans and Auxiliary scholarships. If you have submitted a scholarship application to our parent body, Catholic War Veterans of the United States of America, and are chosen by them as a scholarship recipient, you automatically become ineligible to receive the Catholic War Veterans AUXILIARY scholarship.

CONTEST RULES

- 1. Grade eligibility listed for each contest.
- 2. Posters are to be standard size 11 x 14 inches only. Any type of cardboard or paperboard is OK.
- 3. Students in Contests "A", "B", and "D" may be more creative even attaching items to the poster. Winning posters may be shipped and students should avoid designs in which the effect may be lost if crushed during transit.
- 4. For Contest "C", Grades K-2, the student will observe the theme of Valentine's Day. Student should choose a page from a coloring book that illustrates the theme and color it. These pages should be submitted in the same way as the posters and will be judged in the same way as the posters.
- 5. EVERYONE MUST USE THE IDENTIFICATION FORM. Affix ID Form to entry.
- 6. Only three (3) Entries are to be submitted by each Department per contest.
- 7. Post and Auxiliary not under Department jurisdiction may submit a total of one (1) poster per contest
- 8. All entries must arrive at National Third Vice Commanders address listed below ON or BEFORE THE DEADLINE DATE. Late entries will NOT be judged.
- 9. The decision of the judges is final.
- 10. Contestants need not be present to win.
- 11. Only winning entries will be returned.
