Dear Catholic War Veteran Leader,

The Catholic War Veterans is carefully monitoring the coronavirus situation and its impact on the organization. Since the virus is spread by personal contact, containment efforts stress social distancing by restricting travel, meetings, and other gatherings. Accordingly, the National Department most strongly recommends the following actions to protect our brother and sister veteran and auxiliary members and others.

- Cancel all personal contact meetings, including business meetings, until further notice.
- Cancel all planned events, where people would gather, until further notice.
- Cancel all travel for Catholic War Veteran business until further notice.

There are many ways to continue Catholic War Veteran operations without face to face contact. Here are some suggestions:

- Conduct meetings by conference call, Skype, Google Groups or other methods.
- Use a webinar service for large meetings like monthly business meetings.
- Allow member votes by email or text to approve bills and other post business.
- Use Email for member communications.

Additional information is available for all members and their families on the websites of the CENTERS FOR DIEASE CONTROL and WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION. Be aware that the elderly and sick are highly vulnerable to this disease.
